Place

Herlev Ice rink, Tvedvangen 204, DK-2730 Herlev

The rink is situated approx. 20 km from Copenhagen Airport and approx. 15 km from Copenhagen city center. Indoor heated rink, size 30 x 60 meters.

Rules of the contest

The competition will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Rules and Regulations 2005.

Entries

Springs girls and boys, Debs girls and boys, Novice girls and boys, Junior ladies and men and Senior ladies and men are invited. Please see the enclosed technical data for requirements.

The invitation has been sent to the National associations of Sweden, Norway, Finland, Iceland, Germany, Estonia and Great Britain and to all clubs in Denmark.

The organisation committee reserves the right to limit the entries up to the maximum of **100 participants** in relation to the available time. It might be considered to create more groups from a certain category.

Music

Music will be played from cassette player with normal speed, CD or MD. Music cassettes, CD or MD must be handed over to the Organizer at point of registration. The music medias must be of good quality and must state the full name of the competitor, country, name of club and category in which he or she is entered. All music will be returned to the team leader by the end of the competition.

Judges & technical panel

The participating clubs may propose a judge for the competition. The proposed judge has to be a qualified judge for national championships. Names of candidates should be forwarded to the organiser no later than **December 1st, 2006**. Please state name and address/email address.

The panel of judges will be set immediately after the closing of entries. The members concerned will then be notified. The organiser will arrange accommodation and meals for judges during the competition.

Each participating club may propose one ISU recognized Controller and ISU recognized Technical Specialist. In case of two many nominations the first entered will have the priority. The officials nominated will be posted after the closing date of entries.

Isblomst dinner

The organiser will arrange a dinner on Saturday evening for skaters, coaches, judges, team leaders, the organisation committee and others. Please sign up everybody taking part in the event. Please note that the deadline for signing up for the social event will be Friday January 26th.

Meals

It is possible to buy meals, snacks and drinks at the rink throughout the competition.

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Entry fee

The entry fee is DKK 300 (40 Euro) for Small Beginner and Beginner for each skater and for Novice, Junior and Senior the entry fee is DKK 400 (55 Euro) for each skater.

For participation in the Isblomst dinner the fee is DKK 100. (14 Euro)

Technical data

Seniors:

According to the ISU Technical Rule Single and Pair skating 2006, Rule 310, paragraph 2, and Rule 320 and the respective ISU Communication.

Juniors:

According to the ISU Technical Rule Single and Pair skating 2006, Rule 310, paragraphs 1 and 3, group B for 2006/2007 and Rule 320 and the respective ISU Communication.

Novice:

Age and requirements in accordance with ISU Communication No. 1288 (Guidelines for Novice Competitions) and Communication No. 1324 (Clarification of ISU Communication No. 1288)

Girls and Boys Age limits:

May not be younger than ten (10) and must not have reached the age of fifteen (15) by July 1. 2006.

For Danish skaters "Stort bronze" is required.

Short Program, Novice Girls:

Short program: Girls max. 2 min. 30 sec.

The Short Program for Girls' Singles shall consist of the following elements:

- a) Axel Paulsen or double Axel Paulsen
- b) Double or triple jump immediately preceded by connecting steps. It is not allowed to repeat the jump in a)
- c) One jump combination consisting of two double jumps or one double and one triple jump, both jumps may not repeat jump in a) or b)
- d) Layback or sideways leaning spin (minimum of six (6) revolutions)
- e) Spin combination with only one change of foot and at least one change of position (minimum of five (5) revolutions on each foot). The minimum number of revolutions required in a position is two (2). In case this requirement is not fulfilled, the position is not counted.
- f) One spiral sequence consisting at least two (2) spiral positions. A spiral position in order to be counted must be held for at least three (3) seconds. The sequence must follow the rules of juniors and seniors.
- g) One step sequence with full utilization of the ice surface.

Short Program, Novice Boys:

Short program: Boys max. 2 min. 30 sec.

The Short Program for Boys' Singles shall consist of the following elements:

- a) Axel Paulsen or double Axel Paulsen
- b) Double or triple jump immediately preceded by connecting steps. It is not allowed to repeat the jump in a)
- c) One jump combination consisting of two double jumps or one double and one triple jump, both jumps may not repeat jump in a) or b)
- d) Camel or sit spin (minimum of six (6) revolutions). One (1) change of foot is allowed, but it is not allowed to jump in to the spin.
- e) Spin combination with only one change of foot and at least one change of position (minimum of five (5) revolutions on each foot). The minimum number of revolutions required in a position is two (2). In case this requirement is not fulfilled, the position is not counted
- f) Two step sequences of a different nature with full utilization of the ice surface.



Free Program, Novice Girls and Boys:

Free Program:

Girls 3 min. +/- 10 sec.

Boys 3½ min +/- 10 sec.

A well balanced Free Skating Program for Singles must contain:

- a) Maximum of 6 jump elements for Girls and maximum of 7 jump elements for Boys one of which must be an Axel type jump and there may be up to three (3) jump combinations or sequences. Only one jump combination can contain three (3) jumps. A jump sequence can contain any number of jumps, but only two most difficult jumps will be counted. Only two (2) jumps with two and a half (2 1/2) or three (3) revolutions can be repeated either in a jump combination or in a jump sequence.
- b) There must be a maximum of three (3) spins of a different nature, one of which must be a spin combination (minimum of ten (10) revolutions) and one a flying spin without any change of position or foot (minimum of six (6) revolutions). In spins the minimum number of revolutions required in a position is two (2). In case this requirement is not fulfilled, the position is not counted. The number of changes of foot in the spin combination is optional.
- c) There must be a maximum of one step or spiral sequence (at least two (2) spiral positions) that fully utilizes the ice surface. A spiral position in order to be counted must be held for at least 3 seconds.

Debs, girls and boys:

Debs, girls and boys must not have reached the age of 12 by July 1, 2006.

For Danish skaters "lille bronze" is required.

Free Skating only: Girls and boys max. 2.30 min +/- 10 sec.

Springs, girls and boys:

Springs, girls and boys must not have reached the age of 10 by July 1, 2006. For Danish skaters "færdighedsmærket" is required.

Free Skating only: Girls and boys max. 2.30 min +/- 10 sec.

Judging system:

The ISU judging system will be applied for novice, juniors and seniors.

The "6,0" system will be applied for springs and debs.

Awards

The three best placed competitors in each event will be awarded with a medal.

All competitors will receive a diploma.

Liability

The Organiser accepts no liability for injury or damage sustained by competitors or officials, in accordance with ISU Rule 119. Members are expected to provide their own insurance. The Organiser will provide medical service during the competition.
