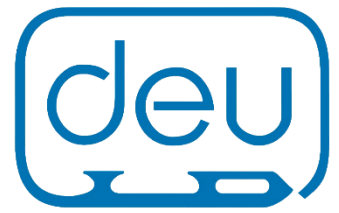


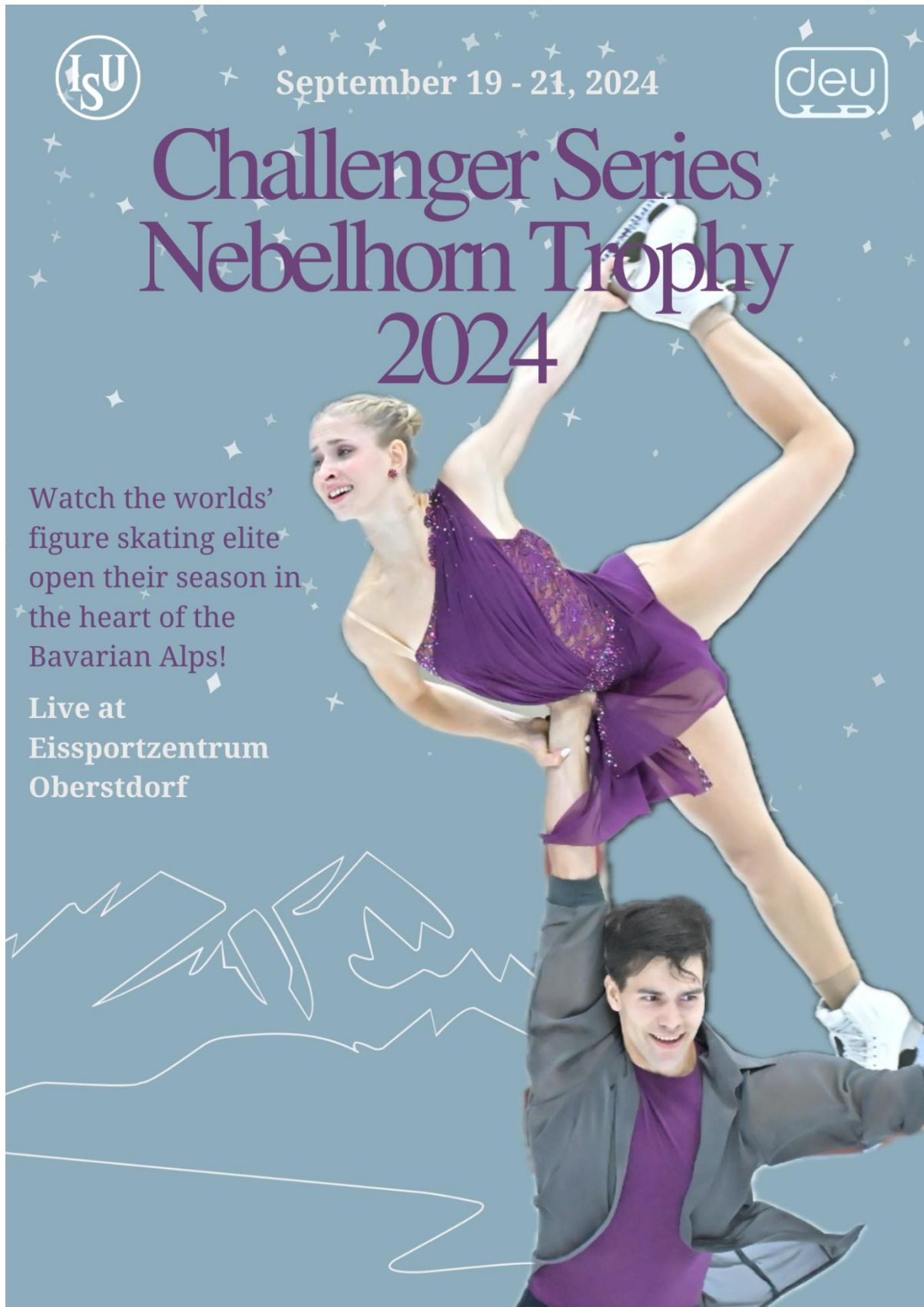

ISU Center of Excellence

Eissportzentrum Oberstdorf

The ISU Center of Excellence is a figure skating facility that focuses on the education of coaches, officials and talented figure skaters, as well as hosting various seminars and workshops.

Here, skaters, coaches and officials have access to experts, services and sufficient on and off ice facilities.

Since 2019 the Eissportzentrum Oberstdorf is one of the ISU Centers of Excellence and provides opportunities for single and pair skaters as well as ice dancers.

Two 30x60m sized fully air-conditioned ice rinks, side by side, one with 1.600 spectator seats and the smaller one with 600 spectator seats and an ice dance rink, used for all kinds of ice sports, with the ice surface of 20x45m, also fully air-conditioned, are the heart of the National Training Centre for Figure Skating in Oberstdorf.

A dormitory school with 44 beds, mainly used by the German Ski Federation, a restaurant, fitness centre, a fully equipped centre for medical treatment and a sauna is available for skaters, living in this centre for a longer or shorter period.

Area

Oberstdorf - heart of the Allgäu

Oberstdorf is located in the southwest of Bavaria, Germany. It is the centre of tourism within the region called „Oberallgäu“. About 10.000 inhabitants live in Oberstdorf, but more than 20.000 beds are available for guests during the year.

The pedestrian area in the village might be the biggest in the World (227.500 square meters) – only a few streets are available for traffic.

Oberstdorf was the first community in Germany, which kept the cars outside the village. The altitude of the village itself is 813m; the highest mountain next door to the Eissportzentrum, the Nebelhorn, is over 2.200m.

All kind of sport activities are possible in Oberstdorf. Magnificent ski areas, more than 200km of well-equipped hiking paths into the 7 valleys, used also for cross-country skiing in the wintertime, mountain climbing, golf, rafting and many other indoor and outdoor sports are offered, but one of the main attractions in Oberstdorf is the National Training Centre for Figure Skating, where we are happy to host the 56th Nebelhorn Trophy.

Arrival and Departure

Trains from Munich Airport - Oberstdorf

Please be aware that there will **not be any shuttle service** from Munich Airport to Oberstdorf this year.

Due to track renovations from **September 9 to November 3, 2024**, in the Sonthofen area, there will be a rail replacement service between Sonthofen/Immenstadt and Oberstdorf with buses.

Long-distance services will start and end in Ulm, with local trains then continuing the journey. The through trains will also be affected.

Please note: There may be changes at short notice, please check again before your arrival and departure!

Music

All Competitors shall furnish by **August 23rd , 2024** competition music of excellent quality via email to music@eislauf-union.de in Mp3 or M4A format, in accordance with Rule 343, paragraph 2.

A list of titles, composers and orchestras of the music to be used for the Short Program and Free Skating Program for Single and Pairs, for the Short and Free Dance Program for Ice Dance and for the Exhibition must be entered on the ISU Portal. Members can download the entered information to send to the Organizing Committee.

Each submission shall be labelled according to the following format:

<Category>_<Segment: SP / FS>_<ISU Member>_<name(s) of competitor(s)>_<Running Time>
e.g. Men_SP_GER_MUSTERMANN_02.40

In addition, competitors/couples must provide a back-up drive (USB-Stick) for each program. If music information is not complete and/or the music is not provided, accreditation will not be given. The Planned Program Content must also be entered by the ISU Member or the Skater(s) on the dedicated ISU platform. It is mandatory that the Program Content information be filled in precisely by each Skater/team in English using the terminology for the elements listed in the respective ISU Communication.

The OC will not accept any submissions via CD.
