
Ladies and Gentleman, dear skaters, dear friends,

## ISU Center of Excellence

### Eissportzentrum Oberstdorf

The ISU Center of Excellence is a center that focuses on the education of coaches, officials and talented figure skaters, as well as various seminars, webinars and workshops.

Here skaters, coaches and officials have access to experts, services and sufficient on and off ice facilities.

Since 2019 the Eissportzentrum Oberstdorf is one of the ISU Centers of Excellence and provides opportunities for single and pair skaters as well as ice dancers.

Two 30x60m sized fully air-conditioned ice rinks, side by side, one with 1.600 spectator seats and the smaller one with 600 spectator seats and an ice dance rink, used for all kinds of ice sports, with the ice surface of 20x45m, also fully air-conditioned, are the heart of the National Training Centre for Figure Skating in Oberstdorf.

A dormitory school with 44 beds, mainly used by the German Ski Federation, a restaurant, fitness centre, a fully equipped centre for medical treatment and a sauna is available for skaters, living in this centre for a longer or shorter period.

# Area Oberstdorf heart of the Allgäu

Oberstdorf is located in the southwest of Bavaria, Germany. It is the centre of tourism within the region called "Oberallgäu". About 10.000 inhabitants live in Oberstdorf, but more than 20.000 beds are available for guests during the year.

The pedestrian area in the village might be the biggest in the World (227.500 square meters) – only a few streets are available for traffic.

Oberstdorf was the first community in Germany, which kept the cars outside the village. The altitude of the village itself is 813 m; the highest mountain next door, the Nebelhorn, is over 2.200 m.

All kind of sport activities are possible. Magnificent ski areas, more than 200 km of well-equipped hiking paths into the 7 valleys, used also for cross-country skiing in the wintertime, mountain climbing, golf, rafting and many other indoor and outdoor sports are offered, but one of the main attractions in Oberstdorf is the National Training Centre for Figure Skating, where we are happy to host the 55th Nebelhorn Trophy.

## Shuttle Service Munich Airport - Oberstdorf

The Organizing Committee is planning to provide a bus shuttle from Munich Airport to Oberstdorf at set times. This year the booking will take place via an online-store system to optimize the process.


## Music

All Competitors shall furnish in advance competition music of excellent quality via e-mail to <a href="music@eislauf-union.de">music@eislauf-union.de</a> until September 16th, 2023, in accordance with Rule 343, paragraph 2. A list of titles, composers and orchestras of the music to be used for the Short Program and Free Skating Program for Single and Pairs, for the Short and Free Dance Program for Ice Dance and for the Exhibition must be entered on the ISU Portal. Members can download the entered information to send to the Organizing Committee.

Each submission shall be labelled with the name of the ISU Member, name of the category, segment and the name(s) of the competitor(s). The music files must be provided in MP3 or M4A format. Any other format is not acceptable. In addition, competitors/couples must provide a back-up drive (USB-Stick) for each program, fulfilling the same requirements.

The exact running time of the music must be communicated to the OC when submitting the music and shall be certified by the competitor/coach/team leader at the time of registration.

Please note: CDs will not be accepted by the OC.
